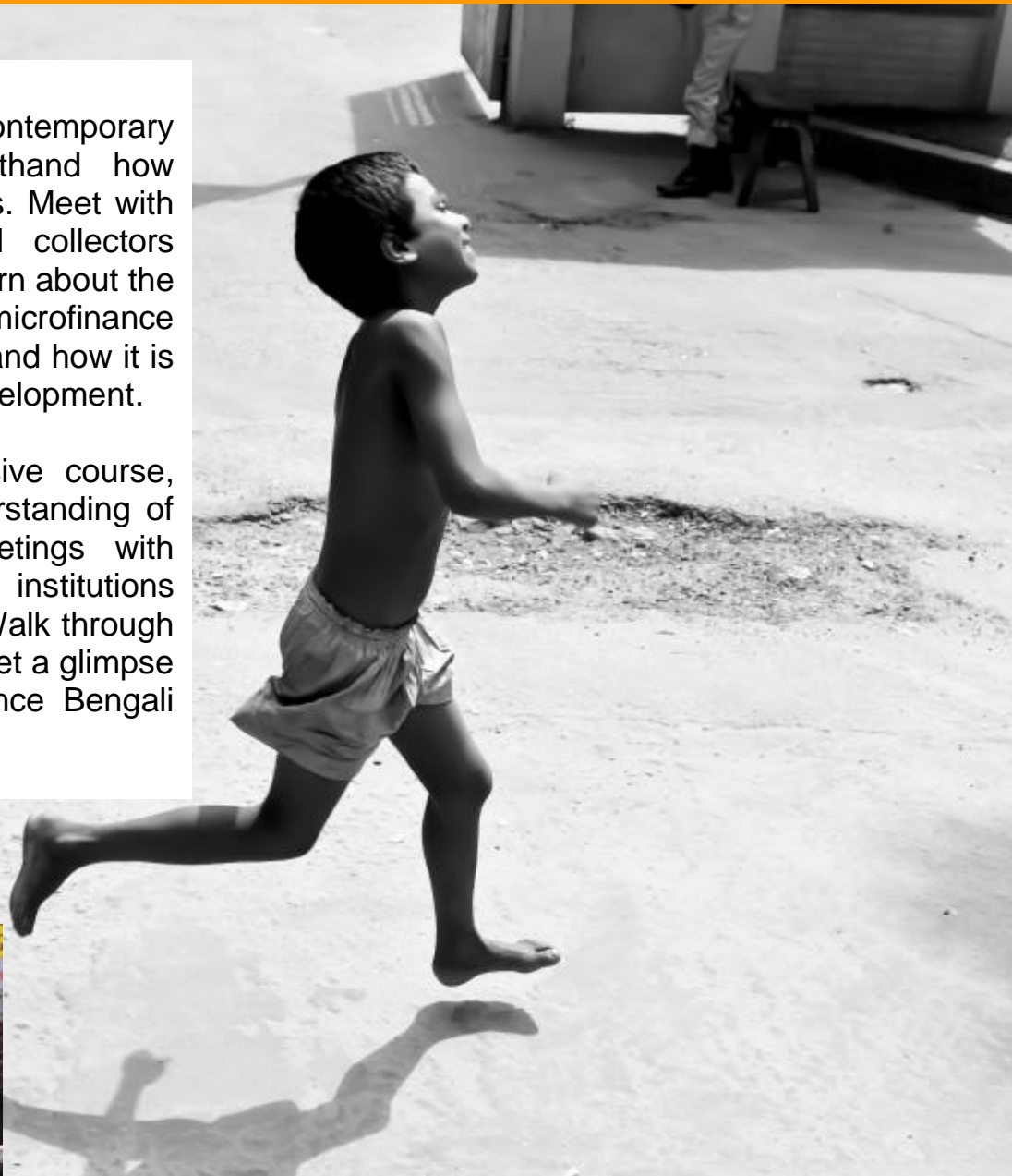


# Understanding Microfinance: Intensive field course in Bangladesh
